Avoid forcing the connector, which can damage the fiber. Route the cable through the cable managers, ensuring smooth curves and adherence to the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. Secure the cable with Velcro straps at regular intervals. Do not over-tighten, as excessive pressure can damage the fiber. Group similar cables together for clarity, such as all uplink fibers or fibers...
