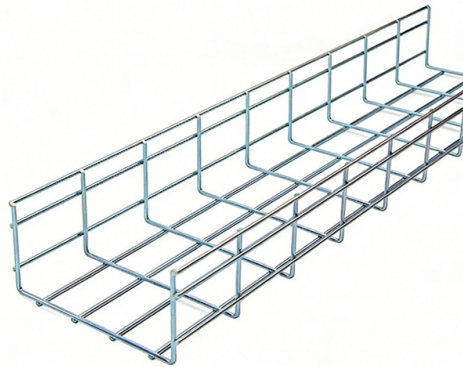


# How to set up a relay protection circuit

6. Safety Considerations Ensure all installation personnel are trained and aware of high-voltage hazards. Follow safety directives and product standards (e.g., EN 60255 series) to prevent injury or equipment damage .
