

How to strip high-temperature optical cables

Mechanical Stripping Mechanical strippers are precision tools designed to remove the protective coating without nicking the glass fiber. Inspect the stripped fiber under a microscope to ensure no coating remnants or scratches remain.

Thermal Stripping Thermal strippers soften the coating with heat before removal, which is particularly effective for high-temperature fibers that may be brittle or have tough coatings. Devices like the Vytran FFS-2000, FiberStrip 7030, or WRXTS6 Thermal Stripper provide controlled heating and ergonomic handling. Guidelines include: Set the temperature according to the fiber manufacturer's specifications. Hold the fiber in a stable position using fiber holders to prevent bending or stress. Remove the softened coating gently to avoid damaging the glass.

Chemical Stripping Chemical methods involve dissolving the coating using solvents or acids, such as sulfuric acid at 120°C for one minute. This method is suitable for fibers with coatings resistant to mechanical or thermal stripping. Safety precautions are critical: Seal the fiber tip with glue or collapse the fiber end to prevent damage. Use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and work in a fume hood. Rinse and clean the fiber thoroughly after...
