- Modulation Type:** NRZ is used in SFP/SFP+; PAM4 is required for SFP56 and QSFP-DD 400G/800G links.
- Compatibility:** Ensure the module matches the host port form factor and supports the intended speed to avoid “No Link” errors.
- Thermal Management:** High-speed modules generate heat; QSFP-DD modules may require optimized heat sinks to maintain 45-55°C in dense AI or HPC deployments.
- Distance and Media Type:** Choose between DAC (Direct Attach Copper) for short links (
