

Installation of cable tray elbows on rooftops

Secure the elbow to supports using manufacturer-approved hardware, ensuring bolts and fasteners are fully tightened. Maintain proper spacing between supports, typically no less than 2 feet from expansion joints or splice plates, to allow for movement without distortion. Check for clearance from rooftop equipment, drainage paths, and other utilities to prevent interference and ensure safe maintenance access. Bond the tray system to the main earthing system to maintain electrical continuity. Cable Protection Ensure that cables are properly routed through the elbow without sharp bends or excessive tension.
