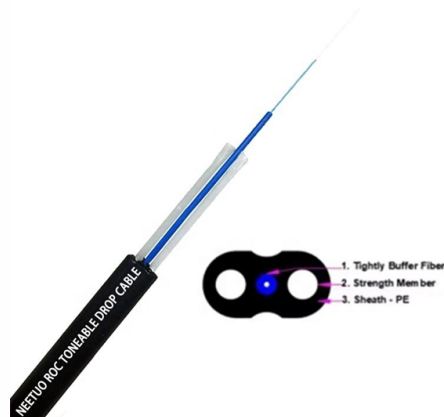


Ireland to Pyongyang Optical Cable

This makes a direct fiber-optic connection from Ireland or any Western European country to Pyongyang technically and politically unfeasible.

Technical and Geopolitical Challenges

Distance and Routing: A direct undersea cable from Ireland to North Korea would require traversing multiple seas and international waters, including the Atlantic, Mediterranean, Indian Ocean, and East Asian waters, which is logistically complex and costly.

International Cooperation: Submarine cables require agreements with multiple countries for landing rights and maintenance. North Korea's isolation and sanctions make such cooperation nearly impossible.

Security and Maintenance: Submarine cables are vulnerable to natural hazards, fishing, and anchoring. Maintaining a cable to a highly restricted country would be extremely challenging and expensive.
