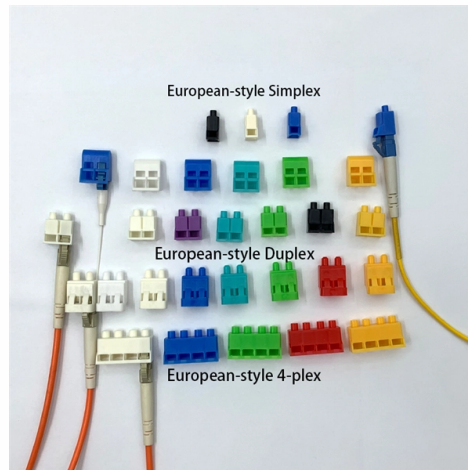

- Bus Bars:** Metal strips that distribute electricity to multiple circuits; include neutral and grounding bus bars.
- Enclosure:** Protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage; materials include polycarbonate, ASA, or powder-coated stainless steel.
- Surge Protective Devices:** Protect against voltage spikes from lightning or unstable power...
