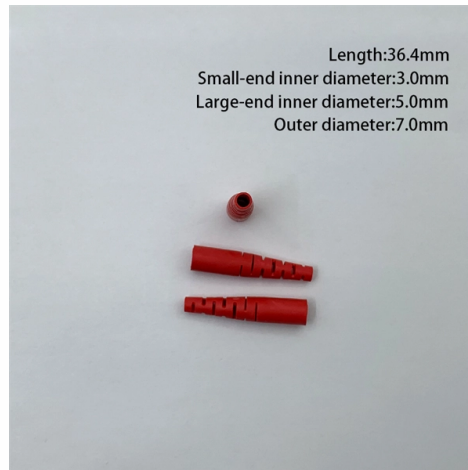

- Near the point where cables enter the building, such as outside walls, basements, or telecom rooms ().
- Dry, secure, and accessible for maintenance and emergency repairs ().
- Environmental protection: Outdoor boxes often have IP68 or similar waterproof ratings to protect against dust and water ().
- Internal organization: Equipped with splice trays, connectors, and adapters to manage fiber or network cables efficiently ().
