- Documentation:** Record all inspections, repairs, and replacements to track equipment condition and plan future maintenance .

Conditional Maintenance Conditional maintenance is performed based on alarms or operational thresholds, such as excessive trips, aging indicators, or usage beyond rated durability. This approach optimizes maintenance schedules and minimizes unnecessary shutdowns .

Safety and Preparation Before maintenance, ensure:

- Power shutdown and disconnection** with proper lockout/tagout procedures.
- Personal protective equipment (PPE):** insulating gloves, mats, shoes, helmets, and face shields .
- Grounding and warning signs** for busbars and live components.
- Availability of spare...**
