

Marking the tail rod with fiber optic cable

Marking a tail rod with a fiber optic cable involves identifying, labeling, and preparing the tail fiber for proper splicing and connectivity while following installation standards.

Understanding Tail Fibers A tail fiber, also called a fiber optic patch cord or pigtail, has a connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. It is used to connect fiber optic cables to transceivers or other network equipment through fusion splicing. Tail fibers can be single-mode or multimode, and may have multiple cores (single-core, 4-core, 12-core, etc.) depending on the application. Proper identification of the fiber type and core count is essential before marking or installation.

Marking and Identification Marking the tail rod or fiber involves:

- Labeling the Fiber:** Use durable, legible labels to indicate fiber type, core number, and destination. This ensures easy identification during splicing, testing, and maintenance.
- Color Coding:** Follow standard color codes for single-mode (yellow) and multimode (orange) fibers. Multi-core fibers often use sequential color coding for each core.
- Physical Marking:** For long runs or ducts, marking the tail rod with tags or colored tape at intervals can help technicians locate and manage fibers during installation.

Handling and Installation

- Avoid Twisting:** Twisting the cable can stress fibers. Use a swivel pulling eye when attaching the pull rope to prevent torsion.
- Figure-8 Lay:** When laying out the cable for a long pull, use a figure-8 pattern on the ground to prevent twists and kinks.
- Splicing Preparation:** Strip the fiber coating carefully using specialized stripping pliers, then clean and cleave the fiber before fusion splicing to the tail fiber.
- Connector Interfaces:** Common tail fiber interfaces include SC/PC, LC/PC, FC/PC, and E2000/APC. Ensure the connector type matches the equipment port.

Testing and Verification After marking and splicing: Use a Visual Fault Locator (VFL) or OTDR to verify continuity and detect stress points. Test fibers in one direction at 1550nm for stress losses, and store OTDR traces for project documentation.

At approximately 100m (328 ft.) before the location of the cut, slow the respooler and visibly observe the cable length markings. When the designated foot/meter mark is reached, stop the respooler.
