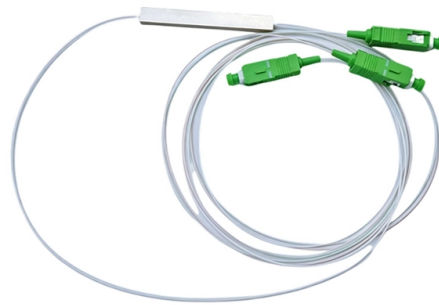


Mesh Cable Tray Bending Process

- 2. Vertical Bend (Up/Down Bend)** Mark the bend location and angle. Cut cross wires along the bend line, leaving longitudinal wires intact. Bend the tray upward or downward to the desired angle, ensuring smooth curvature to avoid sharp kinks. Secure the ends with protective caps if needed.
- 3. Tee (T-Junction) or Cross Bend** Identify the intersection point and mark the tray. Cut the necessary wires to allow the branch tray to fit into the main tray. Bend the main tray edges slightly to accommodate the branch or cross section. Connect the branch tray and secure with clamps or fasteners.
- 4. Offset Bend (Side Shift)** Mark the start and end points of the offset. Cut cross wires along the offset lines. Bend the tray in two stages to create the lateral shift, maintaining alignment with the cable path.

Safety and Tips Avoid cutting all wires completely; leaving some longitudinal wires intact preserves strength. Work slowly and evenly to prevent deformation. Use protective gloves and eye protection when cutting and bending. Check the bend angle with a protractor or angle guide to ensure accuracy
