- Environmental Conditions:** Outdoor or corrosive environments may require thicker or coated materials (e.g., hot-dip galvanized or aluminum alloys) to resist corrosion.
- Standards Compliance:** NEC Article 392, NEMA VE 1, and IEC 61537 provide guidelines for tray thickness based on duty class and material type.

Practical Recommendation

For most industrial and commercial installations:

- Light-duty trays: 1.2–1.5 mm
- Medium-duty trays: 1.5–2.0 mm
- Heavy-duty trays: 2.0–2.5 mm

Always verify the manufacturer's specifications and consider future cable expansion, environmental exposure, and support spacing when selecting the minimum thickness.
