They are particularly useful in areas where network expansion or temporary deployment is needed, such as construction sites, events, or rapidly growing residential areas. Connection Between the Boxes The connection between a mobile primary fiber distribution box and a primary distribution box is typically achieved using backbone or feeder fiber cables. The fibers from the primary box are routed into the mobile box, where they are spliced or connected via patch cords to the internal distribution trays or splitters. This setup allows the mobile box to replicate the port structure of the primary box, maintaining organized routing and minimizing the risk of fiber damage or network downtime. The mobile box does not actively process signals; it functions as a passive distribution point, ensuring th...
