Switch Hardware and Licensing For enterprise-grade deployments, Cisco Nexus 5000 Series switches are commonly used. These switches support both physical and virtual Fibre Channel interfaces, with optional expansion modules providing up to sixteen Fibre Channel uplinks. Each port can function as a downlink (to servers) or uplink (to the SAN or other switches). Virtual Fibre Channel interfaces require a Storage Protocol Services license (N5010SS or N5020SS) to become operational. Interfaces can operate in multiple modes: F (Fabric), E (Expansion), TE, NP, and SD, depending on the network design.

Network Topologies When connecting multiple switches via fiber optic cables, the topology choice is critical:

- Star Topology:** All devices connect to a central switch, which manages traffic. This topology reduces collisions and is suitable for high-performance networks, especially when using fiber optics to handle large data volumes.
- Daisy Chain Topology:** Switches are connected sequentially. This is simpler and cost-effective for small deployments (up to three switches), but lacks redundancy and can be disrupted if one switch fails.

Configuration Steps

Interface Configuration: Use the switch CLI to configure physical or virtual Fibre Channel interfaces. Assign each interface a mode (F, E, SD) and configure speed, MTU, and buffer-to-buffer credits as needed.

VSAN Assignment: Each Fibre Channel interface is automatically assigned to VSAN 1 by default. Modify VSAN assignments if multiple SANs are required.

FCoE Setup: For Fibre Channel over Ethernet, configure FCoE-capable Ethernet interfaces to carry both Ethernet and Fibre Channel traffic. Virtual Fibre Ch...
