Can extend network distances significantly, up to 80–140 km depending on data rate and fiber type. Often use SFP modules for flexible deployment and easy replacement.
- Mode Conditioning Patch Cables (MCP)** Special duplex patch cords with SMF on one end and MMF on the other, designed to launch longwave lasers into MMF without distortion. Useful for connecting GBIC or SFP transceivers with LX/LH outputs to MMF backbones.
- Advanced Optical Add-Drop Multiplexers (OADM)** Integrated systems for high-capacity networks, capable of converting fiber modes and wavelengths within data centers or telecom networks.

Practical Considerations Ensure wavelength compatibility and data rate matching between MMF and SMF ends. Check whether the converter supports full-duplex or half-duplex operation. Installation should allow adequate ventilation and secure placement. Using external converters or transponders avoids voiding switch warranties, unlike replacing SFPs internally.
