- IECEx (International)** Provides a globally recognized certification for equipment used in explosive atmospheres. IECEx certification ensures compliance with IEC standards and is often accepted as a basis for North American installations in Zoned Areas (NEC 505), though it is not fully compatible with the NEC Division system.
- NEMA (United States)** The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) defines enclosure types and protection levels, including NEMA 7 and 9 for hazardous locations. NEMA ratings indicate resistance to dust, water, corrosion, and flame propagation.
- NEC (National Electrical Code, United States)** NEC classifies hazardous locations into Class I, II, and III, with divisions or zones specifying the likelihood of explosive atmospheres. Explosion-proof enclosures must meet NEC requirements for...
