National Standards

In the United Kingdom, the BS 1363 standard defines the design and safety requirements for electrical sockets and plugs. It features a three-pin rectangular configuration with a larger earth pin, mandatory fusing in plugs, and shuttered socket outlets to prevent accidental contact with live parts. BS 1363 operates at 230 V and 50 Hz and is widely adopted in residential, commercial, and industrial settings.

Industrial and Enclosure Standards

Industrial sockets and distribution boxes often require IP (Ingress Protection) and IK (Impact Protection) ratings to ensure durability and safety. For example, Legrand's industrial enclosures comply with IP66 (dust-tight and protected against powerful water jets) and IK10 (hi...
