It is a test done to measure the resistance between a grounding electrode and earth. Specialized earth testers, like the Fluke 1630-2 FC Earth Ground Clamp and the Fluke 1625-2 GEO Earth Ground Tester, are the troubleshooting tools built to make earth ground. ed grounding kits shall be UL Listed, CSA Certified and RoHS compliant. Grounding strip and connectors shall be tin-plated. ll components shall be bonded to the rails with paint. Most multimeters are designed for measuring voltage, current, and resistance in low-power circuits. 56, the maximum grounding resistance is 25 ohms. Ground electrodes provide a safe path to Earth for the dissipation of fault currents, lightning strikes, static charges, and EMF/RFI signals. Testing is required unless otherwise specified.
