- Labeling:** Clearly label each cable and port using a consistent system. This simplifies troubleshooting and future upgrades.
- Bundle and Secure:** Group cables in manageable bundles using Velcro straps or cable ties, avoiding excessive bending or tight loops.
- Color Coding:** Assign colors to different cable types or network segments to quickly identify connections.
