Each router receives its own IP and manages its own network segment, suitable for multi-apartment setups or small businesses.

- IP Addressing:** Most residential ISPs provide only one public IP, so the second router usually shares the first router's connection.
- Network Performance:** The first router should handle NAT and DHCP to prevent conflicts. The second router can extend coverage or create a separate subnet.

- Configuration:** Ensure the second router is compatible with the first and supports Access Point mo...
