- Separation Distances:** Standards such as the National Electrical Code (NEC) and other local regulations recommend maintaining a minimum horizontal separation of 12 inches between power and communication cables. This distance can be reduced to 6 inches if a continuous rigid barrier or conduit separates the cables. For buried installations, a soil separation of 12–24 inches is generally recommended for safety and ease of locating cables later.
- Regulatory Compliance:** Many jurisdictions require adherence to local codes and permitting before trenching. Utilities may have specific rules for co-locating cables, and some standards allow shared ducts only if all utilities involved agree and prope...
