Key Components of a Fire Protection Power Supply

Mains Supply: The primary power source for fire protection equipment is the AC mains, typically supplied via an independent circuit from the main distribution board. This ensures that the fire system is not affected by other electrical loads and is protected by an isolating device such as a circuit breaker.

Battery Backup: A standby battery is essential to maintain system operation during mains failure. For most residential and commercial systems, the battery should support at least 72 hours of standby operation and provide audible and visual indication of mains failure. Batteries are usually VRLA (Valve-Regulated Lead-Acid) and must be appropriately sized for the connected load.

Distribution Outputs: Modern fire power supplies often feature multiple DC outputs, each fused individually, to safely distribute power to devices such as sirens, detectors, and control panels.

Compliance and Certification: Power supplies performing mandatory fire alarm functions must comply with EN54-4 and may also carry VdS certification. These standards ensure features like low current consumption, deep discharge battery protection, battery impedance monitoring, and reliable relay outputs.

Fire-Rated Distribution Boxes

Fire-rated enclosures (e.g., OBO FireBox) are designed to maintain electrical function during a fire for specified durations (E30, E60, E90). They use high-temperature-resistant ceramic terminals and halogen-free housings to prevent toxic gas release and ensure mechanical and electrical integrity. Boxes come in various sizes to accommodate different cable cross-sections and allow branching with separate fuse holders.
