3. Simplex and Duplex Cable Preparation For zip-cord duplex cables, cut the connecting membrane about 1 inch and gently separate the two simplex fibers. Prepare each simplex cable according to the connector or splice specifications.
4. Fiber Stripping and Cleaning Strip the tight-buffered fiber using appropriate strippers without nicking the fiber. Clean the bare fiber with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to remove any residue.
5. Cleaving Use a precision cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end face on the fiber. A proper cleave is essential for low-loss fusion or mechanical splicing.
6. Connectorization or Splicing For mechanical splicing, align fibers in a splice holder and secure. For fusion...
