- Distribution Blocks:** Components like PTFIX or PTVFIX blocks organize and distribute current within the DB box. Isolation plates can be positioned near these blocks to prevent accidental bridging between terminals.
- Safety Interlocks and LOTO:** Isolation plates support lockout/tagout procedures, ensuring that circuits remain de-energized during maintenance.
