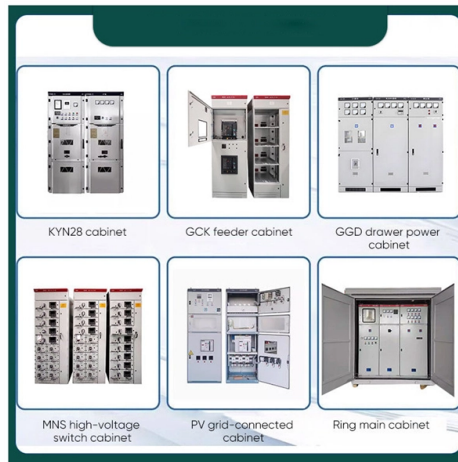

Occupational safety standards, such as those set by OSHA, govern worker safety during tower construction and maintenance.
