Armored cables may be used under raised floors to protect against crushing. Installation Practices Pathways and Supports: Use cable trays, conduits, or inner ducts to protect fibers. Vertical runs should preferably be dropped rather than pulled upward, and fiber should not be mixed with heavy copper cables to avoid stress. Handling: Never pull on the fibers directly; always use the outer jacket or strength members. Maintain the minimum bend radius and do not exceed the maximum pulling tension. Use breakaway pulling eyes, automated pullers, or pulling tape to prevent twisting or damage. Service Loops: Provide adequate slack for main...
