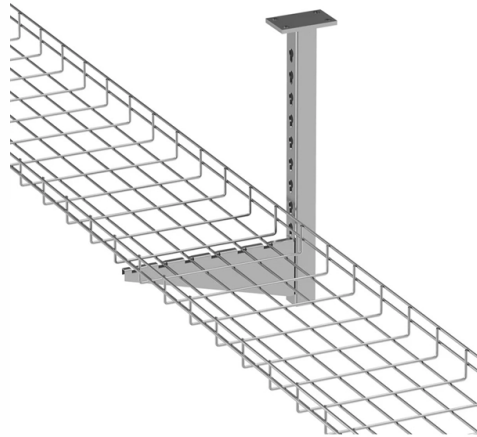

- Enclosure Selection:** Choose steel or plastic enclosures based on environmental conditions. Ensure proper IP/NEMA ratings for dust and water protection.
- Wiring and Grounding:** Use correct wire gauge, secure grounding, and proper insulation. Earth conductors should be at least half the size of the largest phase conductor, not less than 6 mm².
- Protection Devices:** Each circuit should have its own breaker, fuse, or surge protector. Short-circuit protection is mandatory to prevent equipment damage and fire hazards.
- Labeling:** Clearly label all devices and terminals with durable, legible markings resistant to te...
