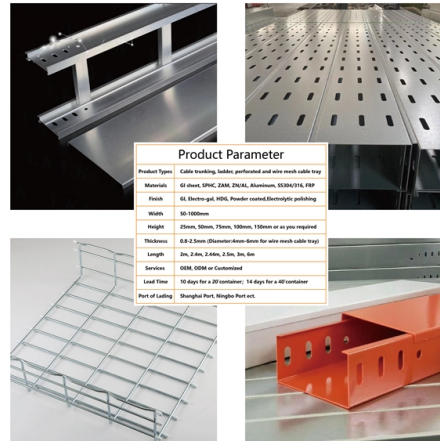


Safety Standards for Lighting Distribution Boxes

Proper Grounding and Earthing: Essential to prevent electrical faults and ensure safety .

Enclosure and Installation Requirements

Material and Construction: Stainless steel or corrosion-resistant enclosures with a minimum thickness of 2mm; IP30 protection for indoor use, with acid-proof, corrosion-proof, and waterproof properties .

Layout and Space: Adequate room for wiring, terminals, and expansion modules; proper ventilation to prevent overheating .

Access Control: Lockable cabinets with inner and outer doors to prevent unauthorized access .
