Wastewater and Stormwater Distribution Boxes For catch basins and D-Boxes in wastewater or stormwater systems, Polylok D-Box seals are widely used. These seals are designed to be watertight and compatible with multiple pipe sizes: 4" seals can be torn along pre-marked lines to fit 2", 3", or 4" pipes without cutting, maintaining integrity. 6" seals are pre-cut for 6" pipes and are installed by pushing the seal from inside the box and securing it with a nut from the outside. For corrugated pipes, special care is needed to cut between raised ribs without damaging the seal. These seals prevent leakage, infiltration, and ensure proper alignment of pipes entering the distribution box.

Explosion-Proof and High-Stress Installations In high-risk or explosion-proof environments, galvanized steel pipes with threaded connections are recommended. Sealing must ensure a tight, robust interface to prevent gas or dust ingress and maintain structural integrity. Minimum wall thickne...
