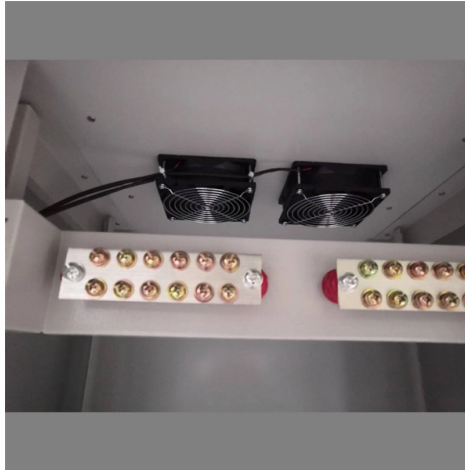


Spacing of fiber optic cable clips for inbound applications



Overview

Proper cable clip spacing is essential for safety, neatness, and preventing sagging or damage. General spacing guidelines: light cables 12-18 inches, medium cables 8-12 inches. Where reels are supplied with protective material fitted over the cable, the protection should remain in place until the cable will be installed. During installation, all curvatures should be smooth.
