- Inspect the Fiber Cable:** Look for visible damage, ensure there are no sharp bends, and confirm the cable is properly connected.
- Reboot the Router:** Turn off the router, unplug it for 30–60 seconds, then power it back on. This can resolve temporary signal issues.
- Verify Connections:** Ensure all cables, including power, LAN, and fiber, are securely connected. Tighten any loose connectors gently.
- Contact ISP Support:** If the red LOS light persists after checking cables and rebooting, the issue may be on the provider's side or require a technician to inspect...
