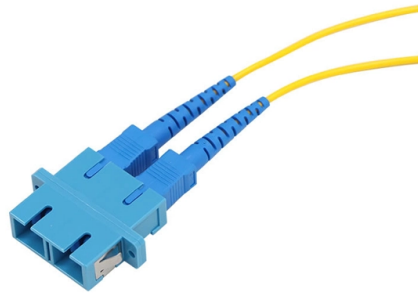

Hot-Swap Capability: Optical modules can be inserted or removed while the switch is powered on, simplifying upgrades and maintenance. Compatibility: Even if a module physically fits, it will only operate at the intended speed if the switch supports that data rate and the module conforms to the required standards.
