Extreme Switches On Extreme Networks switches, you can view optical module and port status:

- Port Status:** show port displays link connectivity, negotiation, and flow control.
- Optical Module Diagnostics (DDM):** show media provides real-time temperature, voltage, Tx/Rx optical power, and alarm thresholds.
- Module Identification:** Confirms vendor, part number, serial number, and wavelength to ensure compatibility.

Brocade and FICON Switches For Brocade Fibre Channel switches, basic configuration viewing includes:

- Listing logical switches and ports:** switchshow or lsportshow
- Checking fabric parameters and FICON settings:** fabricshow
- Verifying licenses and feature keys:** licenseShow
- Monitoring port status and BB_Credit settings for FICON operation:** Key Considerations

Ensure the switch has the correct licenses for Fibre Channel or FCoE features before attempting to view or configure interfaces. Use the appropriate CLI commands for your switch model; Cisc...
