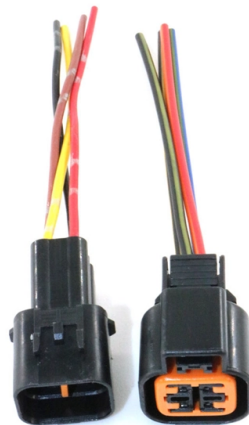


Wall frame fabrication for electrical distribution box installation
