- By Fiber Mode**
 - Singlemode (OS1, OS2):** PVC jackets can encase singlemode fibers for indoor or short-distance outdoor runs. OS1 is used for indoor, shorter distances, while OS2 supports longer distances and higher throughput.
 - Multimode (OM1-OM5):** PVC jackets are compatible with multimode fibers, commonly used in LANs, data centers, and campus networks. OM3, OM4, and OM5 support higher speeds (10G-100G) and longer distances, often using VCSEL lasers.
- By Fiber Count and Configuration**
 - Simplex:** Single fiber strand, used for unidirectional transmission or bidirectional transceivers.
 - Duplex:** Two fiber strands for full-duplex communication, ideal for standard transceiver pairs.
 - Multi-fiber (MPO/MTP):** High-density PVC cables for data centers and backbone networks, supporting multiple fibers in a single jacket.
