- Solid Bottom Tray:** Provides maximum protection from dust and moisture, often used for telecom and fiber-optic cables.
- Trough (Ventilated) Tray:** Offers a balance between strength and protection, with good ventilation.
- Wire Mesh Tray:** Lightweight, flexible, and easy to modify on-site, suitable for data centers and control rooms.
- Channel Type:** Used for lighter cable loads in commercial and institutional applications.
- Fiberglass (FRP) Tray:** Non-conductive and highly corrosion-resistant, ideal for harsh environments.
