

What size cable tray should a 75 cable be paired with



Overview

If using 75 mm height trays: Use a 600 mm wide × 75 mm deep tray. Add spacing, brackets every 2. IEC 61537 covers cable tray and cable ladder systems for the support and accommodation of cables, while NEC Article 392 governs cable. What cable tray sizes are standard?

Standard cable tray widths per IEC 61537 and manufacturers' ranges are typically 50, 75, 100, 150, 200, 225, 300, 400, 450, 500, 600, 750, 900, and 1000mm.
