

What to do if the pigtail cable can't be pulled out



Overview

Gently pull the wires out: Once the terminal screws are loosened, gently pull the wires out of the old pigtail connector. Be careful not to tug or yank on the wires too forcefully to avoid damaging them. I suppose you could try using a tool in the a lot between the control box and the pig tail to help pry it up. It is possible that when you get the wire end out, it is nicked in which case it is a good idea to snip it off and trim more insulation off to expose more bare wire. If you have too many wires for the screws, cut a short length (pigtail) of the same color, wire nut this to the various wires in.
