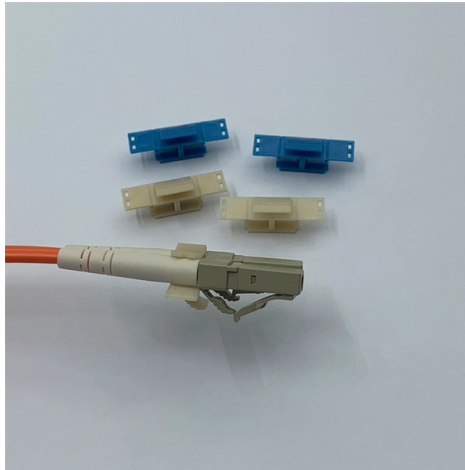


Wire binding in the mesh cable tray

Insert the tie through the mesh and around the cable bundle, then tighten snugly without crushing the cables. Trim excess tie length to prevent snagging or injury.

Alternative Lacing Method For long or heavy cable runs, lacing cord can be used to tie cables in a figure-eight pattern along the tray. This method distributes tension evenly and allows easier adjustments or additions later.

Maintain Separation and Organization Group cables by type or function to simplify maintenance. Avoid over-tightening ties, which can damage insulation or reduce airflow. Leave some slack at bends and exits to prevent stress on connectors.

Inspection and Adjustment After securing, check that cables are evenly supported and not sagging. Ensure that no sharp edges of the mesh are in contact with cable insulation; use edge protectors if necessary.

Best Practices Use UV-resistant or stainless steel ties for outdoor or high-temperature environments. Avoid running power and data cables together in the same bundle to reduce interference. Regularl...
