- Single-phase 220V appliances: one phase, one neutral, and one ground wire.
- Three-phase 380V equipment: three-phase lines plus ground, with neutral if needed for control.

Each circuit is protected by an individual circuit breaker or fuse, ensuring safety and isolating faults.

Neat cable management is essential; wires should be dressed and secured with cable ties, leaving space for heat dissipation. Grounding is mandatory for safety, though sometimes omitted in temporary setups like construction sites. Insulation checks should be performed before powering the system to prevent short circuits or electric shock.
