Distribution Boxes Purpose: Distribution boxes (or panelboards) distribute electrical power from a main source to multiple circuits, housing breakers, fuses, or terminal blocks. They provide environmental protection and allow safe access for maintenance.

Wiring Considerations:

- Metal Enclosures:** Ensure electrical continuity by bonding all metal parts and grounding properly.
- Cable Entry:** Use appropriate knockouts, bushings, or conduit entries to prevent abrasion.
- Voltage and Current Ratings:** Match wiring and breakers to the system voltage and load requirements.
- Temporary Wiring:** If used during construction, feeders must originate from a distribution center, and all boxes must have covers, with metal covers grounded.
