

Wiring of switches in the home electrical distribution box

Earth connection: connect the earth wire to the switch box (if metal) and to the device for safety.

Wiring Configurations **Single-Pole Switch:** One switch controls one load. Phase wire goes to the switch, load wire goes to the device, neutral bypasses the switch. **3-Way Switch:** Allows control of a single load from two locations. Requires two traveler wires between switches and proper identification of common terminals. **4-Way Switch:** Used with two 3-way switches to control a load from three or more locations. Connects between the traveler wires of the 3-way switches. **Switch-Controlled Socket:** One pole of the switch connects to the phase line, the other pole to the socket's live terminal. Neutral and earth are connected directly to the socket. **Safety and Best Practices** Always follow local electrical codes and regulations. Use correct wire gaug...
